Join us for a day of discussion and field application of the Minnesota Floristic Quality Assessment (FQA). We will begin the day with a discussion of the background and methodology of the FQA. This will be followed by the application of the FQA in the field. We will have a number of opportunities utilizing this tool in several different wetland plant communities. We will also have the opportunity to learn the basics of plant identification from several experienced field botanists from the region. The field trip will include a great opportunity to see the wetland flora of this region at an optimal time of year.

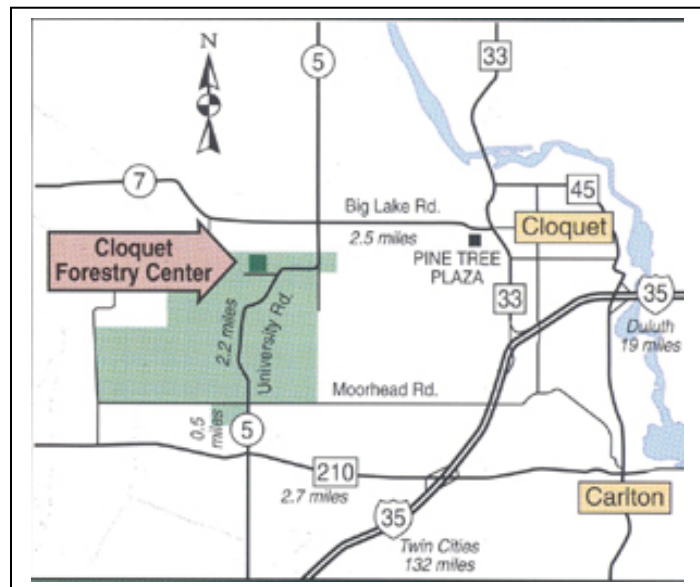
